Community of Music Makers rekindles that joy of music-making

The San Francisco Symphony's
Community of Music Makers (CoMM)
program is an initiative that serves amateur
adult musicians and promotes active,
lifelong participation in music-making.
Launched during the Orchestra's 2011-12
Centennial Season, CoMM extends the
Symphony's role beyond its historic
performance and teaching model by
creating opportunities for SFS concertgoers
to participate in music-making under the
auspices of the SFS and with the support of



SFS artistic resources. Community of Music Makers presents workshops and events for amateur vocalists and instrumentalists in Davies Symphony Hall, where participants improve their skills, meet fellow musicians, and receive coaching directly from SFS musicians and artistic staff.



Each choral workshop involves four SFS Chorus members as mentors; numerous other SFS Chorus members serve as workshop volunteers. For the instrumental workshops, 15 members of the San Francisco Symphony serve as coaches and mentors, allowing participants to interact in a very personal way with the SFS musicians they see on stage. Chamber music workshops allow for intimate, in-depth musical explorations with an SFS musician serving as a mentor for each chamber group. These "behind the scenes" interactions are enriching for mentors and participants alike.

The Goal of Community of Music Makers is to enrich people's lives through music-making and direct participation with the classical repertoire; and to promote inclusiveness and connectivity between the Symphony's artists and educators and the Bay Area community. Our hope is that Community of Music Makers will help to deepen participants' experience as listeners and performers, as part their lifelong engagement with music.
