Musicians of the San Francisco Symphony have performed Music in the Wards concerts regularly over the past six years.

Dozens of musicians have participated, playing solo or in small ensembles, with instruments ranging from the violin to the contrabassoon!

A typical Music in the Wards performance is about an hour long and happens once per month—with music and conversation interspersed.

The Symphony's budget includes musician and crew fees, and we always provide at least one staff member to be present during the in-person or virtual event.
