Lightbulb Snowperson Ornament

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Supplies:

- Old Lightbulb
- White Acrylic Paint
- Yarn Scraps
- 1"x5" Cardstock Strip of Paper
- Glitter
- Black & Orange Permanent Marker or Acrylic Paint
- Paint Brush
- Tape
- Scissors
- Wire

Instructions:

Step 1: Wrap your strip of paper tightly around the metal part of the lightbulb and tape in place. This is the snowperson's hat. Remove the paper and place to the side for later.

Step 2: Paint the glass part of your lightbulb white and roll around in or sprinkle on glitter. Set aside to dry.

Step 3: Cut 20 strings of yarn 15" in length. Grab the snowperson's hat.

Step 4: Fold one string of yarn in half. Bring the folded end of the string through the center of the snowperson's hat. Wrap the two loose ends of the string around the outside of the hat, through the loop, and pull tight [See Images Below].



Step 5: Repeat with the remaining strings of yarn until the paper is covered all the way around making sure the string ends are all on the same side.

Step 6: Once the lightbulb is dry, place the hat on the metal part to make sure it fits snugly. You should be able to hold the lightbulb by the hat. Adjust the size of the strip of paper as needed.

Step 7: Once your hat is fitting just right, cut a long piece of wire and use it to bring the loose yarn string ends together closing off the hat.



Step 8: Cut the very ends of the string so they are all the same length. This should look like a pompom at the top of a winter hat.

Step 9: Connect the ends of the wire together by twisting them. This is how the ornament will hang.



Step 10: To finish transforming your lightbulb into a snowperson, use a permanent marker or paint to add buttons, eyes, mouth and nose to your snowperson. Finish off by tying the three strings of yarn around your snowperson's neck to create a scarf.
